But I realize that not everyone has that type of time or desire. Or others may want to test the Shakespeare waters before they dive in completely. I've tried to include everything in this short Shakespeare mini unit that you would need to sample Shakespeare – both who he was and what he wrote. There is a brief timeline of his life and his plays, a little about him as a person, and where he fit in history.
