Jane Ridley ' s colorful biography rescues the man once derided as " Edward the Caresser " from the clutches of his historical detractors. Excerpts from letters and diaries shed new light on Bertie ' s long power struggle with Queen

Victoria, illuminating one of the most emotionally fraught mother-son relationships in history. Considerable attention is paid to King Edward 's campaign of personal diplomacy abroad and his valiant efforts to reform the political system at home. Separating truth from legend, Ridley also explores Bertie 's relationships with the women in his life. Their ranks comprised his wife, the stunning Danish princess Alexandra, along with some of the great beauties of the era: the actress Lillie Langtry, longtime "royal mistress" Alice Keppel (the great-grandmother of Camilla Parker
