“ immortality ” until
more than twenty
years after her death,
when scientists
investigating HeLa
began using her
husband and children
in research without
informed consent.

had launched a
multimillion-dollar
industry that sells
human biological
materials, her family
never saw any of the
profits. As Rebecca
Skloot so brilliantly

Lacks family—past
and present—is
inextricably
connected to the dark
history of
experimentation on
African Americans,

and the legal battles
over whether we
control the stuff we
