In 2010, more than 105,000 people were injured or killed in the United States as the result of a firearm-related incident. Priorities for Research to Reduce the Threat of Firearm-Related Violence focuses on the characteristics of firearm violence, risk and protective factors, interventions and strategies, the impact of gun safety technology, and the influence of video games and other media.
