Cilia are microscopic finger-like cell-surface organelles possessed by a great many eukaryotic organisms, including humans, whose purposes include generating local fluid movements via rhythmic whip-like beating and environmental sensing. Despite intense research efforts since their discovery by van Leeuwenhoek in the 1670's, several key questions regarding ciliary functions, experimental manipulation and in silico imitation remain unanswered. His story includes the rescue and his eventual adoption of two young siblings--Mia and Marky, who were born in Haiti. Section 2 features the lives of five abolitionists, a mix of heroes from past to present, who call us to action and teach us life lessons based on their own experiences: Harriet Tubman--The "Conductor"; Abraham Lincoln--the "Great Emancipator"; Little Mia--the sister who saved her little brother; Guesno Mardy--the Haitian father who lost his son to slave traders; and Harriet Jacobs--a teacher for us all.

Throughout human history, wars and violence have often been waged in the name of religions and in the name of diverging religious beliefs and belonging. Ironically, though, all religions in their teachings speak of nonviolence and have in common the promotion of peace and justice, namely the respect of human life and dignity, the institution of human rights, the protection of the poor and vulnerable, the freeing of the oppressed, the active elimination of injustice? It seems therefore, that violence and wars would be antithetical to religions; yet they are so frequently used as their justification. Are we then speaking of different "religions"? I wanted to prove that their path, irrespective of their original religion, would be similar, and that their diverse faith, instead of separating them, would on the contrary end up uniting them.
