How to speak. Speak clearly and calmly. Speak at a slightly slower pace, and allow time between sentences for the person to process the information and respond. This might seem like an uncomfortable pause to you, but it is important for helping the person to communicate. Avoid speaking sharply or raising your voice. Use short, simple sentences.
