Too often, our study of the Bible focuses on searching for specific information or some formula that will solve our pressing needs of the moment. reliable guide for Christian spiritual formation. According to Foster, the Bible is all about human life "with God." By opening our whole selves—mind, body, spirit, thoughts, behavior, and will—to the page before us, we begin to grasp all the Bible has to teach about prayer, obedience, compassion, virtue, and grace and apply it to our everyday lives to achieve a deeper relationship with God.
