Linear Programming Word Problem Example:

A refinery produces both gasoline and fuel oil, and sells gasoline for \$1 per gallon and fuel oil for \$0.90 per gallon. The refinery can produce at most 600,000 gallons a day, but must produce at least two gallons of fuel oil for every gallon of gasoline.

Linear Programming Word Problems And
For a problem to be a linear programming

problem, the decision variables, objective function and constraints all have to be linear functions. If the all the three conditions are satisfied, it is called a Linear Programming Problem .

0.1 Linear Programming

Linear programming is basically a fancy term for a constrained optimization problem consisting of linear constraints and a linear objective function. In this word problem, we formulate a set of constraints and an objective function, graph the feasible region, identify corner points, and finally plug those points into the objective to find the maximum profit.
