practically every
genre: Baum
wrote 55 novels in
total, 82 short
stories, more than
200 poems, as
well as scripts,
and other
miscellaneous
writings.

many of his non-
Oz works were
published under
pseudonyms.
Baum made many
attempts to bring
his work to stage
and screen, but
the most
successful
productions were
not made until
after his death.
