Vissing provides a planning model for improving support networks within communities and challenges Americans with a fundamental philosophical question: Do homeless children merit fullscale social intervention? Ultimately, *Out of Sight, Out of Mind* compels us not merely to voice concerns for family and community values, but also to assert this commitment consciously through improved essential services.
