war, Timothy Ballard founded a modernday "underground railroad" which has rescued hundreds of children from being fully enslaved, abused, or trafficked in thirdworld countries. His story includes the rescue and his eventual adoption of two young siblings--Mia and Marky, who were born in Haiti. Section 2 features the lives of five abolitionists, a mix of heroes from past to present, who call us to action and teach us life lessons based on their own experiences: Harriet Tubman--The "Conductor": Abraham Lincoln--the "Great Emancipator"; Little Mia--the sister brother: Guesno Mardy--the Haitian
