En 2016, tras casi treinta a ñ os de vigencia de la CIE-9-MC y coincidiendo con la implantaci ó n de un nuevo modelo de datos del CMBD que pas ó a constituirse en Registro de Atenci ó n Especializada, RAE-CMBD, se dio paso en Espa ñ a a la CIE-10-ES como clasificaci ó n de referencia para la codificaci ó n cl í nica y registro de la morbilidad en aplicaci ó n del Real Decreto 69/2015 que regula el mencionado registro. La CIE-10-ES integra dos clasificaciones, la de diagn ó sticos que corresponde a la modificaci ó n cl í nica estadounidense de la CIE10 (ICD10CM) y un sistema de clasificaci ó n de procedimientos, las cuales fueron traducidas y validadas por el Ministerio en colaboraci ó n con expertos de Comunidades Aut ó nomas y Sociedades Cient í ficas.
