F-86 Sabre Pilot's Flight Operating Manual Rarebooksclub.com

Built as both a fighter-interceptor and fighter-bomber, the F-86 Sabre (sometimes called the Sabrejet) was one of the most widely-produced fighters of the Cold War. In December of 1950, three squadrons of Sabres were rushed into combat in Korea, where they duelled North Korean, Chinese and Russian pilots flying the MiG-15. By the time the war was over, F-86 pilots achieved a stunning victory ratio - destroying nearly 800 enemy aircraft with a loss of only 76 Sabres. The nimble jet also saw combat in the Taiwan Strait Crisis and the Indo-Pakistan Wars of 1965 and 1971. Originally printed by North American and the U.S. Air Force, this F-86 Flight Operating Manual taught pilots everything they needed to know before entering the cockpit. Classified "Restricted," the manual was recently declassified and is here reprinted in book form. This facsimile has been reformatted and color images appear in black and white. Care has been taken to preserve the integrity of the text.

Purpose and Scope a. This manual is for personnel concerned with the organization and functions of interior and exterior guard. It includes orders, countersigns, parole words, and responsibility of the main guard including duties of personnel and methods of mounting the guard.

The manual also discusses the duties and composition of special guards. b. As this manual is a guide, and as all possible situations and eventualities cannot be foreseen or covered by the manual, great reliance must be placed upon the application of sound judgment and common sense by all members of a guard and by all security personnel. In situations not covered by this manual and where doubt arises as to the proper action to be taken, the individual must consider his mission and apply sound judgment in making the required decision(s).

PREFACE This manual is a guide for commanders and their staffs in the procedures and techniques of foot marches. It describes the march mission, characteristics and types of foot marches, and march training to include planning procedures, duties of commanders, march discipline, march hygiene, and march safety. The material herein applies to all levels of conflict without modification. General Visual signals are any means of communication that require sight and can be used to transmit prearranged messages rapidly over short distances. This includes the devices and means used for the recognition and identification of friendly forces. PREFACE The purpose of this publication is to assist individual service members, unit commanders unit leaders, and field sanitation teams (FSTs) in preventing disease and nonbattle injury (DNBI). Their position in active operations, is in advance of the works previously executed, that the fire from them may keep down that of the enemy, and thus allow of the subsequent works being constructed with as small a loss as possible. They should be arranged, if possible, so that they may be afterwards converted into parallels. Sapheads should be covered by detached rifle-pits 30 or 40 yards in advance." 206. "Detached rifle-pits are made each to contain one man, Detached and are in the shape of an inverted frustrum of a cone with a seat rifle-pits, in rear. The diameter of the top and bottom respectively is 4 ft. 6 in., and 2 ft. 6 in., while the depth is 4 feet; the amount of excavation (including the seat in rear) being 39 cubic ft., a man should complete one in an hour, requiring a pick shovel, and four sand-bags

"The dimensions of the connected rifle-pits are as follows: Connected--5 feet long, 4 feet wide, and 3 ft. 3 in. deep; a seat 1 ft. 6 in. rifle-pits, wide, and deep, is cut in rear. The pits are placed about 30 feet from each other, and are connected by means of a trench 2 feet wide, and 3 ft. 3 in. deep. (Figs. 192 and 193.) One man is told off to make the pit, and three to the communication. The amount of earth each man excavates is 65 cubic feet. The first thing each man should do is to sink down to the full depth in the left of his work, so as to obtain cover, and then complete his task to the required dimensions. The rifle-pit and communications should be finished in two hours. Each man requires one pick-axe and one shovel. Loopholes should be formed in the parapets of rifle-pits, parallels, &c., as described in section 97." Section 14.--HASTY...
