Scott Fitzgerald, stationed at Camp Zachary Taylor during World War I, frequented the bar in the famous Seelbach Hotel, immortalized in *The Great Gatsby*. Muhammad Ali was born in Louisville and won six Golden Gloves tournaments in Kentucky.

integration a failed experiment rightfully abandoned. Using oral history narratives, newspaper accounts, and other documents, Tracy E.
