"Edinburgh's New Town was created thanks to the determination and vision of a group of leading citizens led by Lord Provost George Drummond. Having obtained the permission of Parliament to extend the city's royalty to the open fields beyond the Nor' Loch, (now Princes Street Gardens.) The City, very commendably, decided to organise a competition to design what even then was called The New Town. This competition was won in 1766 by a young 23 year old architect James Craig. His plan was a simple but very effective grid-iron design with three parallel streets running from east to west with a grand square at either end of the principal street which was to be named George Street after the King, George III. The foundation of the first house, which still stands, in Thistle Court, was laid in November 1767. Progress westwards though was slow. It was not until 1792 that work started on the houses of Charlotte Square at the west end of George Street. Although commercial development has spoiled much of Princes Street, the majority of Edinburgh's first New Town has survived the passage of time. It remains as one of the finest surviving examples of The Yugo SCB Distributors Georgian Town Planning and as such was recognised, along with the neighbouring Old Town, as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1995.
