6 Car Noises to Keep an Ear Out For: 1. You hear a high-pitched squeal when accelerating: If you notice a loud squeal when accelerating, especially if your car is just warming up, it could be that you have a loose or worn fan belt. Usually if your fan belts are worn, it could mean your timing belt needs replaced as well.

Most manual transmission issues originate not with the transmission itself, but from related components like the clutch assembly, linkage, or driveline: the components that transmit turning power from the transmission to the wheels.

Automatic transmission noises can be minor or serious; it really depends on where it's coming from. Automatic transmission noises are often very different than engine noises. They're usually constant, either a whine or growl during transmission operation. Sometimes you get the occasional tick or thump as well.

I just got the new transmission in the car (broke two teeth off of the intermediate shaft) and it shifts like butter but our drivetrain noise still remains. When I originally discovered the noise I looked under the car and found one of the rear axles had a torn boot and had slung grease everywhere.

If the clutch is squealing when you depress the pedal then it may be possible that the clutch disc is worn or contaminated. If the clutch disc or pressure plate, located inside of the transmission, become dirty or contaminated they can cause the clutch to make noise when released and engaging.

Manual Transmission Release Fork Noise If a manual transmission makes noises just when the clutch pedal is all the way up or engaged and a grinding or rattling noise is heard, the throw-out bearing for the clutch is bad. If the transmission makes a rattling noise that is loudest in neutral, although it is always there, and the noise changes when it is put into gear, but shifts well, the input shaft bearing is bad.

Whining and humming are transmission noises that suggest two different problems but are often hard to distinguish. Whining indicates a problem with the transmission fluid pump and could be due to a low level or a failing pump.

Usually a high pitched squealing or grating noise. There's really no way to identify this problem positively without disassembling the clutch. Use the Clutch Replacement procedure to

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disassemble and inspect but, exhaust all other possible causes first as this is a tedious procedure.

If noise develops from the bell housing area, a few checks can be done. Start with a road test of the vehicle. Listen for noise with the transmission in gear and the clutch pedal to the floor. Next release the clutch with the transmission in first gear. Noise under this condition indicates a worn release bearing or a worn pilot bearing.

If you hear a constant whining noise, accompanied by a slip in the gears as the transmission automatically shifts, it points to low transmission fluids. Without the proper fluid level, the pump has to push air through the transmission, which causes the noise and produces the hesitation or slippage.
