Open iTunes, under the "Summary" tab, check if "Manually manage music and videos" is enabled or not, if it is then try toggling it off and on again, and then manually drag a song over to the iPod classic nano/shuffle/touch to force manual syncing.

Connect your iPod touch to your computer with the connection cable. Open iTunes if it does not open automatically. Click the name of your iPod under "Devices" on the left side of the iTunes window. Click the "Summary" tab in the center of the iTunes window. Check the box next to manually manage music and videos. Click "OK".

If you haven't made any sync selections, the default is to copy everything in your iTunes library that your iPod model can play. An iPod touch can play everything including apps, and show photos and videos from your photo library. An iPod classic can play everything but apps, and show photos and videos.
