Njoroge, his childhood friend, can abandon neither the idealism of his youth nor his love for Vic ' s sister Deepa. But neither the idealism of the one nor the passive cynicism of the other can avert the tragedies that await them. The In-Between World of Vikram Lall is a profound and careful examination of one man ' s search for his place in the world, with themes that have run

work: the nature of community in a volatile society, the relations between colony and colonizer, and the inescapable presence of the past.
