And in 1940 – 41, he used cut paper to resolve the compositions of two paintings. Though he would not consider a cut-out to be an autonomous work of art until 1946, the groundwork was laid to create through this technique. The cut-outs “ were a long time in the making, ” Matisse acknowledged, developing in secret.

Of course not; but Henri Matisse 's colourful paper cut-outs have riled a few. In fact these online cynics are rehashing some time-honoured criticism: that last hostile sound-bite was not punched into the ether by an angry Guardian reader, but comes from a sceptic in 1949,

reacting to the paper creations Matisse had exhibited at Paris ' s Mus é e National d ' Art Moderne.
