Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering. Students are eligible to apply to the BSME degree program after completing successfully a specific set of prerequisite courses. A grade of 2.0 or equivalent is required in all courses applied to the BSME degree. UW Bothell and UW Seattle course equivalents are shown.

Graduate Admission | Mechanical Engineering

In general, you must maintain an average GPA of 2.50 across placement requirements to remain in good academic standing in the CoE and to be able

to request placement in a major. A grade of 2.0 or above is needed for each course required for placement. Exception: BioE requires a 2.5 grade in Chem 162.
