The office component is a structural analysis software program that can be used to generate thresholds which are used for identifying isolated events. The field component includes hardware and field monitoring software

performs data processing and evaluation. The hardware system consists of sensors, data acquisition equipment, and a communicatio n system backbone. The field monitoring software has been developed such that, once started, it will operate autonomously with minimal

user interaction. In general, the SHM system features two key uses. First, the system can be integrated into an active bridge management system that tracks usage and structural changes. Second, the system helps owners to identify damage and d eterioration Springer

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
