 1/8 tsp. salt  
 1 tsp. dry bread crumbs  
 1/4 tsp. Worcestershire sauce  
 1 tsp. minced fresh or frozen onion  
 dash of black pepper  
 1 tbsp. milk  
 Mix all ingredients in 1-quart mixing bowl. Shape into 5-inch patty and set aside. Heat 6" browning skillet 2 minutes at 100% power. Place patty in skillet and cover skillet with paper towel. Cook 1:30 minutes at 100% power, turning patty over halfway through cooking time. Let
