Your name, the professor's name, the course number, and the date of the paper are double-spaced in 12-point, Times New Roman font. Dates in MLA are written in this order: day, month, and year. Titles are centered and written in 12-point, Times New Roman font.

Double-space the entire research paper, including quotations, notes, and the list of works cited. Indent the first line of a paragraph half an inch from the left margin. Indent set-off quotations half an inch as well (for examples, see 76–80 in the MLA Handbook). Leave one space after a period or other concluding punctuation

mark, unless your instructor prefers two spaces.

**General Guidelines** Type your paper on a computer and print it out on standard, white 8.5 x 11-inch paper. Double-space the text of your paper and use a legible font (e.g. Times New Roman). Leave only one space after periods or other punctuation marks... Set the margins of your document to 1 inch ...
