This means that the author's last name and the page number (s) from which the quotation or paraphrase is taken must appear in the text, and a complete reference should appear on your Works Cited page.

In-Text Citation Style in the MLA Paper Format . The MLA in-text citation distinguishes it from other documentation systems. Basically, the MLA paper format uses parenthetical in-text citations, which follow the author-page format. This MLA style citation consists of an author ' s surname and the specific page number where the cited information was extracted. If the source does not have the author ' s surname, people repeat the title of the article in the parentheses.

Citing a Case Study with In-Text Citations and Footnotes in MLA When it comes to citing a case study in a body of a paper, a student should use a parenthetical citation (in-text) by indicating the last name of the author and the page number in a case study from where the information is picked.

MLA in text citation example: “ Everything goes away, Jack Sawyer, like the moon. Everything comes back, like the moon ” (King, Steven, and Straub 78). When there are more than 3 authors, only list the last name of the first one and type “ et al. ” MLA in text citation example: “ He ’ d thought about it, why mundane kids might come to the Academy. Mundanes would have to choose to give up their parents, their families, their former lives.

Revised on October 27, 2020. An MLA website citation includes the author ’ s name, the title of the page (in quotation marks), the name of the website (in italics), the publication date, and the URL (without “ https:// ”). If the author is unknown, start with the title of the page instead. If the publication date is unknown, or if the content is likely to change
