The MOHOST is an assessment that addresses the majority of MOHO concepts (volition, habituation, skills, and environment), allowing the therapist to gain an overview of the client's occupational functioning.

By using a model of occupational therapy in which leisure is a key component, assessments such as the Model of Human Occupation (MOHO) interest checklist, volitional questionnaire, role checklist or other standardized assessments of performance components such as assessment of motor and process skills (AMPS), will identify performance skill, balance of occupations, preference and opportunity for choice.
