In addition to aiding in the protoindustrialization of Japan by 1800, tea had by that time become a central commodity in the formation of a burgeoning consumer society. The demand-pull of tea

consumption necessitated even greater production into the postwar period—and this despite challenges posed to the industry by consumers' growing taste for coffee.
