Letters Home by Harry Truman Harper Collins  
This book is dedicated to Aristid Lindenmayer on the occasion of his 60th birthday on November 17, 1985. Contributions range from mathematics and theoretical computer science to biology. Aristid Lindenmayer introduced language-theoretic models for developmental biology in 1968. Since then the models have been cus tomarily referred to as L systems. Lindenmayer's invention turned out to be one of the most beautiful examples of interdisciplinary science: work in one area (developmental biology) induces most fruitful ideas in other areas (theory of formal languages and automata, and formal power series). As evident from the articles and references in this book, the in terest in L systems is continuously growing. For newcomers the first contact with L systems usually happens via the most basic class of L systems, namely, DOL systems. Here "0" stands for zero context between developing cells. It has been a major typographical problem that printers are unable to distinguish between 0 (zero) and 0 (oh). Thus, DOL was almost always printed with "oh" rather than "zero", and also pronounced that way. However, this misunderstanding turned out to be very fortunate. The wrong spelling "DOL" of "DOL" could be read in the suggestive way: DO L Indeed, hundreds of researchers have followed this suggestion. Some of them appear as contributors to this book. Of the many who could not contribute, we in particular regret the absence of A. Ehrenfeucht, G. Herman and H.A. Maurer whose influence in the theory of L systems has been most significant.

In 2009-10, there were an estimated 3.1 million adults with diabetes in England and this is expected to increase by 23 per cent to 3.8 million by 2020. The Department estimates that it has increased its spending on diabetes services from £0.9 billion in 2006 - 2007 to £1.3 billion in 2009-10. The NAO considers these figures to be a substantial underestimate, and estimates that NHS spending on diabetes services in 2009-10 was at least £3.9 billion, or around four per cent of the NHS budget. The Department's data show that only half of people with diabetes received the recommended standards of care in 2009-10, even though the proportion has increased from 36 per cent in 2006-07. The standards originally set in 2001, state that people with diabetes should receive nine basic care processes each year but no primary care trust achieved the aim of delivering all nine basic care processes to all people, with the highest trust scoring 69 per cent and the lowest just 6 per cent. Furthermore, fewer than one in five people with diabetes are achieving recommended standards for controlling glucose, blood pressure and cholesterol levels. As well as diminishing quality of life, diabetic complications place a significant burden on the NHS. The Department also estimates that up to 24,000 people die each year from avoidable causes related to their diabetes. There is significant variation in the quality of care received by people with diabetes which cannot be satisfactorily explained. Through better management of people with diabetes, the NHS could save £170 million a year.
