Long Time-Exposures (M Mode Only)

Unlike other cameras with traditional "PASM" dials, the Nikon D800 / D800E do not have such a dial and require using the MODE button instead. So if you need to switch between different camera modes, you need to hold the MODE button and rotate the rear dial.

Manual Focus To focus in manual focus mode $(0\ 101)$, rotate the lens focus ring until the subject is in focus. To magnify the view in the monitor up to about $23\times for$ precise focus, press the X button.

Press the I button and rotate the main command dial until M is displayed in the control panel. Choose a shutter speed. While the exposure meters are on, rotate the main command dial to choose a shutter speed of Bulb (A) or Time (%). The exposure indicators do not appear when Bulb (A) or Time (%) is selected.
