The TTL feature of a Nikon dedicated flash will only work
with Nikon, however, it could possibly still be used in
manual mode. In a nutshell, TTL is the way that the camera
sets the exposure and flash intensity automatically by firing
a nearly imperceptible pre-flash, taking an exposure
reading, and adjusting settings accordingly.

Going manual, as Trev points it out every so often, I have no problem balancing foreground/flash and ambient/background using the diverse compensation dials on cam and on the flash in iTTL or just aperture/time/manual flash. However, this fails horribly if I enter any one of the automatic modes.
