NRP (Neonatal Resuscitation) Training - NorCal CPR ...

In 2015, the Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) published updated guidelines for neonatal resuscitation. Key additions to the 2015 NRP algorithm include consideration of using 3-lead electrocardiography (ECG) to monitor heart rate (HR) and

initiating intubation before chest compressions.

Neonatal resuscitation / NLS / Newborn Life Support pre 2015 guidance

– The 2017 NRP guidelines recommend a 30- to 60-second delay in clamping in all term and preterm infants not requiring resuscitation. – If the placental circulation is disrupted (e.g., placental abruption), the cord should be clamped immediately.
