When people live with a serious health problem or disability, or as they get older, it can become difficult for them to get around in their homes, and to independently and safely complete everyday...
Case Study: Training - The OT Practice
Dressing garments overhead (This method can be used for jerseys, shirts, vests and nightgowns) Step 1: Place your weak hand into the sleeve and pull sleeve over your shoulder. Step 2: Pull the neck opening over your head. Step 3: Place your unaffected arm into the sleeve. (steps 2 and 3 may be reversed)

For the first two weeks following your operation we advise that you have a strip wash and avoid having a bath or shower as you will need to keep the wound and dressing on your hip dry. After this time you can use a walk-in shower as normal but will not be able to step in / out of the bath or sit in the bottom of the bath for the first two months.

Try to keep it fun by playing dressing up games and dressing toys. When dressing dolls, try using a doll which your child can relate to as being of a similar age. This will give your child a clearer idea of how to organise dressing.
An example of an OT Initial Assessment notes entry
This type of assessment is typically used for personal care tasks like showering, dressing, toileting, brushing teeth, grooming etc. The great thing

about assessing through occupation is that you can also take into account habituation and the role of long term memory, motor memory, problem solving and insight into abilities.
