Purpose: The purpose of this document is to implement the Office of Management and Budget's (OMB) Final Information Quality Bulletin for Peer Review (hereafter referred to as the Bulletin), which were issued on December 16, 2004, and published in the Federal Register on January 14, 2005 (FR 70:2664–2677).

OMB's Peer Review Bulletin established government-wide guidance aimed at enhancing the practice of peer review of the federal government's science documents. It requires federal agencies to systematically plan for peer review of influential scientific information (including highly influential scientific assessments) that the government intends to disseminate in the foreseeable future.

In general, an agency conducting a peer review of a highly influential scientific assessment must ensure that the peer review process is transparent by making available to the public the written charge to the peer reviewers, the peer reviewers' names, the peer reviewers' report(s), and the agency's response to the peer reviewers' report(s).

OMB Peer Review Disclaimer. Based on the review it has conducted, the U.S. Department of Education believes that it does not currently produce or sponsor the distribution of influential scientific information (including highly influential scientific assessments) within the definitions promulgated by OMB.

Bulletin for Peer Review | GSA

OMB's peer review bulletin requires that US federal regulatory agencies submit all "influential scientific information" to peer review before the information is publicly disseminated. The Bulletin defines "scientific information" as:
