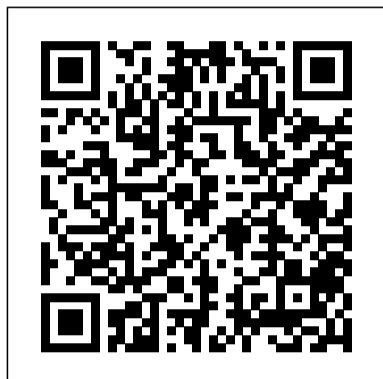

Vauxhall cars have been central to motoring in Britain for over a century.
