LECTIO DIVINA: Listening to God. Reading the Bible and praying the Bible are two very different

undertakings. To pray the Bible is to apply listening and silence to the Word of God in order to hear God speak. This prayer method known as lectio divina, “divine reading” or the sacred reading of scripture, is being practiced by more and more young people and youth groups today as they seek to listen to God.
