Owl Pellets Investigation - The Biology Corner

The owl first passes the undigested material to a secondary stomach called the gizzard (or muscular stomach) where the mass is packed into a pellet. The pellet is then spit back out. Sharp objects, such as bones and claws are packed into the middle of the pellet, while softer structures, such as hair are on the outside.
