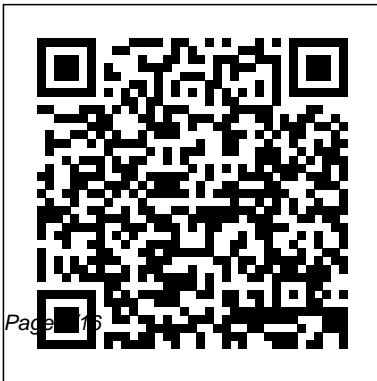

In 1985, forty hooligan followers of Stoke City FC experienced a
