Some people think that a cookbook is just a collection of recipes for dishes that feed the body. In *Eat My Words: Reading Women's Lives through the Cookbooks*

They Wrote, Janet Theophano shows that cookbooks provide food for the mind and the soul as well. Looking beyond the ingredients and instructions, she shows how women have used cookbooks to assert their individualit y, develop their minds, and structure their lives. Beginning in the seventeenth
