Most self-published books are trade paperbacks. Manuals and workbooks are larger and, depending on the printing equipment being used to produce them, are in the 8" x 10" to 8-1/2" x 11" range. This size is also good for directories and instructional books with lots of graphics or detailed drawings to follow.

The most common trim size for paperbacks in the U.S. is 6" x 9" (15.24 x 22.86 cm). When setting up your book, this is the default in the "Print Options" section of the Paperback Content tab. If you want a different trim size, click Select a different size and choose from standard and non-standard trim sizes.

Book Sizes for Print-on-Demand Books

The most popular is 6" x 9". That means the book is 6" wide and 9" tall (depth isn't measured at this stage). It's a fairly chunky size, not exactly suitable for slipping into a purse. 5" x 8" and 5.5" x 8.5" are the next most popular sizes and are sometimes called "trade paperback" size.

Color books have the same trims available and print books between eight and 250 pages. The most common trim sizes for standard trade fiction and nonfiction books include: 5" x 8", 5.5" x 8.5", and 6" x 9". But there are a number of other trim size options you can choose from, shown in the chart below.

It's important to decide on a suitable trim size earlier on in your book production as it's required to determine such things as; the cost to print and ship it and how ...

The Most Popular Standard Book Sizes - For the US & UK

Trade paperbacks, a pretty loose category of books, are often in the 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" to 6" x 9" range. This page proportion—for instance in the 6" x 9" size—of 2:3 has long been considered an ideal for a book page, and you can create good looking books at different sizes but in the same page proportions.

To format your paperback cover,

you'll first need to calculate the spine measurements (black and white books, color books). Insert the spine measurements, selected trim size width and height, and the 0.125" (3 mm) bleed requirement into the following equations to find your cover size:

Experiment to find the font that best fits your

paperback. Set some sample pages in your selected font.

When you see a whole page with thousands of characters on it, you'll have a sense of whether the font matches your book's content and tone.

Standard UK Book Sizes. There are several common book sizes. These sizes are based on the most cost-effective use of standard paper sizes (ie how many pages can be fit onto a sheet). The choice is yours, but we can advise you if the size can be changed slightly to make it more economical.

Book details. As you add text to your cover, make sure it exactly matches the book details (e.g., title, author name, edition, ISBN) entered during title setup. Font size and color. Text should be at least 7-point font so it's large enough for customers to read.

Hardcover (or hardback) sizes vary widely in the US, but generally the size of these books tends to fall somewhere between 6 x 9 in and 8.5 x 11 in. Self-publishers tend to avoid hardcovers in favor of cheaper paperbacks, but with more POD sites offering hardcover print runs at increasingly better value, it's starting to become more of a realistic option for self-published authors.
