This volume contains the papers presented at the "Second International Symposium on Foundations of Information and Knowledge Systems" (FolKS 2002), which was held in Schloss Salza, Germany from February 20th to 23rd, 2002. FolKS is a biennial event focusing on theoretical foundations of information and knowledge systems. It aims to bring together researchers working on the theoretical foundations of information and knowledge systems and to attract researchers working in mathematical fields such as discrete mathematics, combinatorics, logics, and finite model theory who are interested in applying their theories to research on database and knowledge base theory. FolKS took up the tradition of the conference series "Mathematical Fundamentals of Database Systems" (MFDBS) which enabled East-West collaboration in the field of database theory. The first FolKS symposium was held in Burg, Spreewald (Germany) in 2000. Former MFDBS conferences were held in Dresden (Germany) in 1987, Visegrád (Hungary) in 1989, and in Rostock (Germany) in 1991. Proceedings of these previous events were published by Springer-Verlag as volumes 305, 364, 495, and 1762 of the LNCS series. In addition the FolKS symposium is intended to be a forum for intensive discussions. For this reason the time slot of long and short contributions is 60 and 30 minutes respectively, followed by 30 and 15 minutes for discussions, respectively. Furthermore, participants are asked in advance to prepare as correspondents to a contribution of another author. There are also special sessions for the presentation and discussion of open research problems.
