Through subsequent survey research, Gest also identifies novel ways that leaders can leverage nationalist sentiment to reduce the appeal of nativism--by framing immigration and demographic change in terms of the national interest. Grounded in rich narratives and surprising survey findings, *Majority Minority* reveals that this contentious milestone and its accompanying identity politics are ultimately subject to unifying or divisive governance.
