objective of the Guide is to promote centers that
are child-oriented, developmentally appropriate,
beautiful, environmentally sensitive, health
promoting and functional. The designer needs to
be aware that a child may be in a center up to
12,500 hours if he or she starts as an infant and

spend such long hours at the center, the design of
their spaces is especially critical. The design effort
must allow for, and be sensitive to, the differences
in space attributes for children and those for adults
as well as the differences in space usage by the
children in different age groups. Information about
the characteristics and activities of the children is
included to provide rationale for aspects of design.
The requirements and recommendations set forth
in the Guide are aimed at establishing optimal

design; though, specific maximum or minimum
requirements are stated when appropriate. This
