Find your voice. As a newspaper columnist, you 're charged to have distinct opinions and a voice. Your voice could be humorous or dark, for example. A good way to find your voice is to read newspaper articles that report just the facts, and then

freewriting a response. Do this with 5 or 6 articles, then chart how you reacted.
