Did Plato abandon, or sharply modify, the Theory of Forms in later life? In the *Phaedo*, *Symposium*, and *Republic* it is generally agreed that Plato held that universals exist. But in *Parmenides*, he subjected that theory to criticism. If the criticism were valid, and Plato knew so, then the *Parmenides* marks a turning point in his thought. If, however, Plato became aware that there are radical differences in the logical behaviour of concepts, and the later dialogues are a record of his attempt to analyse those differences, then Plato's
