This regulation, Army Regulation AR 385-10 Safety: The Army Safety Program 27 November 2013, implements the requirements of the

Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 as implemented in Executive Order 12196; Title 29, Code of Federal Regulation 1960; and Department of Defense Instructions 6055.1, 6055.04, and 6055.07.
