Porsche referred to their version of the Type 4 engine using the litre designation and not cc's (i.e.: not 1700 like VW). One visual difference is that all Porsche Type 4 engines have the oil dip-stick and oil fill mounted on top of the engine (where the VW Type 2 engine application has the dip-stick mounted on the rear of the engine by way of a long oil fill tube).
