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Positive Messages for Students That Truly Pack a Punch

Keep your tone positive. By default, many students misunderstand the purpose of feedback and see it as judgment instead of enabling learning. Keep this in mind and go out of your way to be supportive and positive. Judgmental or critical comments can undermine a student's motivation and impede the learning process.

Strategy #1: End Notes (or Head Notes) and Marginal Comments. As described above, one very common approach to commenting on student papers is to combine end notes that provide a “ big picture ” perspective with marginal comments that illustrate specific instances of the strengths and weaknesses described in the end notes.

Writing comments on student papers is something of an art: it requires a little thought and practice for the comments to be effective--that is, both read and attended to. The following recommendations about writing comments were developed for students in writing and literature classes; however, with a little adjustment, they can be applied to any writing assignment.

These comments have two main purposes: to show students that you attentively read the paper and to help students understand the connection between the paper and your final comments. Guidelines for providing feedback to assignments

Don ' t write any more on the paper than the student is going to read and understand. Keep in mind that ambitious students are likely to be more interested in your comments than students who aim only at getting through. Make the most comments on the things you care about the most.

When your student is focused, they are a pleasure to have in class. Let ' s meet to discuss strategies to keep them on track. When you have wonderful, positive things to say ... Positive behaviors deserve just as much (if not more) attention as negative behaviors. These comments can be the most fun to write.

When grading student papers I make in-margin comments throughout and then articulate my overall feedback at the bottom. Additionally, I compose a document with general feedback for the entire class based on positive and negative trends in the papers submitted.
