A phrase or clause between the subject and verb does not change the number of the antecedent. Example: 2. Indefinite pronouns as antecedents. Singular indefinite pronoun antecedents take singular pronoun referents. Example: Plural indefinite pronoun antecedents require plural referents.

**Subject Verb Pronoun Antecedent Agreement Rules - Mobley ...** President Lincoln is the ANTECEDENT for the pronoun. Note that the pronoun must match its predecessor in numbers and in person. In other words, if the precursor is a single noun, then the pronoun that relates to it should also be singular in the number. A pronoun may also refer to a previous noun or pronoun in the sentence. 1.

If the precursor is singular, the pronoun that takes its place must also be singular: the expression pronoun-antecedent agreement actually refers to using the right pronoun to substitute for the noun, and the pronoun that replaces the Noun must approve it in a certain way. The pronoun must agree with the forerunner in number and sex.

Pronoun-Antecedent Agreement : Another name for a noun that is replaced by a pronoun is "antecedent." (The prefix antemeans "before," indicating that the antecedent comes before the pronoun.)
