

## Red Litmus Paper Turns Blue When A Solution Is

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[Blue Litmus Paper - \(Acid test\) - sciencecompany.com](#)

The blue litmus will turn red or pink when it comes into contact with an acidic solution below pH 4.5. Between 4.5 and 8.3 the paper will be purple. Above 8.3 it will stay blue. Supplied in plastic vial, about 100 paper strips/vial. Litmus paper is NOT used to determine the pH level of a solution.

Red litmus paper contain a weak diprotic acid in it. Weak acid that is used in acid - base indicator generally have different color between the acid form and the conjugate base ion form. For example, in red litmus paper, the conjugate base ion has blue color, and it's weak acid is red. So it turns litmus paper blue in colour.

Blue litmus paper turns red under acidic conditions and red litmus paper turns blue under basic or alkaline conditions, with the colour change occurring over the pH range 4.5 – 8.3 at 25 ° C (77 ° F)....

*What Is Litmus Paper?*

This demonstration is to prove: 1. Acid turns 'Blue' litmus paper 'Red' but has no effect on 'Red' litmus paper 2. Alkali turns 'Red' litmus paper Blue' but has no effect on 'Blue' litmus paper.

Red litmus paper and blue litmus paper. Blue litmus paper turns red in the presence of an acid and red litmus paper turns blue in the presence of an alkali.

Red litmus contains a weak diprotic acid. When it is exposed to a basic compound, the hydrogen ions react with the added base. The conjugate base, formed from the litmus acid, has a blue color, so the wet red litmus paper turns blue in alkaline solution.

In an alkaline solution, red litmus paper turns blue. When an alkaline compound dissolves in water, it produces hydroxide ions, which cause the solution to become alkaline. Red litmus paper can also be used to test the pH of a water-soluble gas by dampening the paper and exposing it to the gas.

Red paper turns blue when the pH is alkaline, while blue paper turns red when the pH turns acidic. While litmus paper is most often used to test the pH of liquids, it can also be used to test gases if the paper is dampened with distilled water before exposure to the gas.

Litmus paper is filter paper which has been treated with a natural water-soluble dye obtained from lichens. The resulting piece of paper, called "litmus paper", can be used as a pH indicator. Blue litmus paper turns red under acidic conditions (pH below 4.5) while red litmus paper turns blue under alkaline conditions (pH above 8.3). Blue litmus does not change color under alkakine conditions, while red litmus paper does not change color under acidic conditions.

This single molecule is responsible for indicating both acid and base. The presence of acid causes litmus to turn red while the presence of base (alkali) turns litmus blue.

[What color does red litmus paper turn in neutral ...](#)

Dip a strip of litmus paper into the substance. If it turns red, that substance is an acid. If it turns blue, that substance is a base. If it stays the same, that substance is neutral. Example: Let's take lemon juice for example. Dip a litmus paper strip into the lemon juice. It will turn red as the lemon juice is acidic.

When blue litmus paper is dipped in an acid, it turns red; when red litmus paper is dipped in an acid, it just appears to get wet. Alkacid paper, which is a universal indicator, turns orange or red when it is reacting to an acid, with a redder color indicating a lower pH and a stronger level of acidity.

When red litmus paper is placed into a basic substance, it will turn blue. If it comes in contact with an acidic or neutral substance, it will remain red. Red litmus paper is meant to test only for an alkaline pH level. Common acids include tartar sauce, corn, bacon and beer.
