Travel documents. An alien's passport and a refugee travel document are travel documents given instead of a national passport. They are not official identification documents even if they do not include a remark 'Identity not verified'. You can apply for an official identification document (identity card) from the police.

If you do not obtain a refugee travel document before you leave the U.S., you may be unable to re-enter the United States or you may be placed in removal proceedings before an immigration judge. If you came to Norway as an asylum seeker or resettlement refugee and have been granted protection (asylum), you can be issued a refugee travel document. The travel document is green.

How do I get a refugee travel document? - USCIS

Convention refugees and protected persons can use a Refugee Travel Document (RTD), issued by the Passport Canada, in order to exit and re-enter Canada. A protected person who is not a permanent resident and who intends to travel outside Canada must obtain an RTD from the Passport Office before

leaving Canada by submitting an Adult Travel Document Application (PPTC 190) or a Child Travel ...

Travelling with UK Refugee Travel Document: Visa ...

This travel document allows beneficiaries of refugee status to travel abroad, unless compelling reasons of national security or public order exist. The abovementioned travel document is issued from the Passport Directorate of the Hellenic Police Headquarters, [2] subject to a fee of €85. [3]

UNHCR - Note on Travel Documents for Refugees

A refugee travel document is basically the equivalent of a U.S. passport for asylees and refugees who need to travel outside the U.S. temporarily. (See 8 C.F.R. Part

223 .) If you are a U.S. asylee or refugee, and you want to preserve your right to stay in the U.S. after traveling temporarily abroad, you must apply for a refugee travel document before you leave the United States.
