How Often to Change Transmission Fluid (Manual and Automatic)

Generally, it is recommended to change your manual transmission fluid after you cover at least 30,000 miles or to the max, 60,000 miles. The fluid changing gap depends on the car model greatly. If in case you are stressing your transmission, changing these fluids becomes essential after covering 15,000 miles.

The 3 Series manual transmission has two plugs for filling and emptying the transmission oil, located on the side and bottom of the transmission case. To check the level of the transmission oil, remove the top filler plug on the side of the transmission (where you usually add fluid).

When to Change Manual Transmission Fluid. The fluid of manual transmissions has a shorter lifespan.

The typical manufacturer of a manual vehicle will tell you to change your fluid at around 30,000 to 60,000 miles. Of course, every make and model will likely have a different recommendation, but one that is within this range of miles.

Most manufacturers suggest 30,000 to 60,000 miles as the point at which you should change the transmission fluid in a manual transmission. However, vehicles with transmissions that are under 'high stress' should change the transmission fluid every 15,000 miles.

How Often to Change Transmission Fluid: Manual and Automatic

Use your fluid pump to pump just under two quarts in your transmission. Simply put the hose of the kit into the fill plug, then pump the fluid until it starts falling out. Finally, close the fill plug and tighten it. Figure 3.
